

Frequently Asked Questions at vaccination sessions

Q: Will this hurt, what does it feel like?

- It will be a sharp scratch and will not be too painful

Q: How long does the needle stay in?

- for a few seconds

Q: Is it Halal?

- All vaccinations we offer apart from the nasal flu spray (which contains porcine gelatine) are Halal.

Q: What is it for?

- The nurse on the day will provide all the information regarding the vaccination you are having.

Q: Side effects / how will I feel after?

- Like most injections side effects are mild, stinging and soreness in the arm are common but wear off in a couple of days. More serious side effects are extremely rare.

Q: Will I be able to carry out normal (sports) activities after?

- Yes you will be able to carry out any activities as normal.

Q: Can I have it behind a screen (privacy)?

- Where possible if required we will be able to administer the vaccine behind a screen or in privacy.

Q: Will the vaccine give me the disease?

- Vaccines teach your body how to get rid of these diseases if you come into contact. You may receive a tiny dose of the disease but will be inactivated so not harmful

Q: I've just had my covid vaccine is it safe to have a different vaccine so soon?

- Yes, it is fine to have another vaccine around the time you received your covid vaccine
